To practise parts of the body
To practise vowels
To practise/revise adjectives

Resources and materials

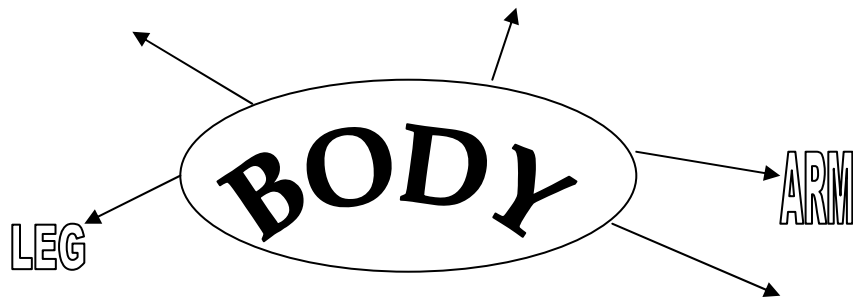
MEC resources 'Parts of the body' (IDs MVA004391 and MVA004327), 'Sounds' (ID MPR003481) and 'The Evil doctor' (ID MGA000060). To find the resources write in "Parts of the body", "Sounds" and "The Evil doctor" in the Word and Phrase Search.

Preparation

- Open MEC up on an IWB or data projector and bookmark the MEC resources above.
- Create a brainstorm map on the flipchart to be completed by the learners. See an example in the activity Brainstorm.
- Screenshot of the 'Sounds' activity (one worksheet per learner).

1. Brainstorm

Open the flipchart with the brainstorm. You may leave the map empty or as below provide a few examples. Learners give as many examples of body parts as they can. The teacher completes the brainstorm map. Alternatively, ask the learners to come and complete the map.



2. Vocabulary Activity Parts of the Body ID: MVA004327

Open MEC up on an IWB or data projector and open Parts of the body. Learners work in pairs and match the parts of the body with the picture. Monitor your learners and help when necessary. Ask learners for their feedback.

3. Pronunciation Activity Sounds

Open MEC up on an IWB or data projector and open Sounds. You can make a screenshot of this activity and pass around a handout with two columns. Give learners a few minutes to work in the same pairs and match the words with the same vowel sound. Monitor learners and help when necessary. Play the recording and check the answers. If you see that your learners need more practice, drill other parts of the body as well.

4. Vocabulary Activity Parts of the body ID: MVA004391

Open MEDO up on an IWB or data projector. Search the vocabulary items from the Work Area.

Open Parts of the body. Put learners into groups of three and give them 10 minutes to do the activity. Monitor your learners and help when necessary. When they have finished ask for their answers.

5. Game The Evil Doctor

Open the game 'The Evil Doctor'. Before you start playing the game with your learners pre teach any key vocabulary items that may be unknown to the learners. Put learners into groups of three and organise a small competition between the groups.
